



## **2024 Youth Tour Application**

Sam Houston Electric Cooperative, Inc. will award an all-expense paid trip to Washington, D.C. for two high school students for the Government-In-Action Youth Tour. Contest winners will join other students from Electric Cooperatives across the nation. This will be an unforgettable look inside U.S. History and Government.

Eligibility Rules and Winner Requirements:

- Applicants must live in the home of parents/legal guardians who are active members of Sam Houston Electric Cooperative, Inc. An active member is defined as someone who is receiving electric service from Sam Houston Electric Cooperative, Inc. with the membership in the name of the parents/legal guardians.
- The winner must be able to participate in the Youth Tour trip to Washington, D.C. on June 16-24, 2024.
- Immediate family members of Cooperative employees or directors are ineligible.
- Applicant must have completed sophomore or junior year of high school by June 2024, or equivalent if homeschooled or a non-traditional student.
- Applicant must have at least one letter of recommendation regarding the applicant's character. The letter may be from a teacher, principal, counselor, employer, supervisor, minister, or others who are not relatives of the applicant.
- Applicant must be 16 years old with a government or state-issued driver license, ID or passport by June 16, 2024.
- Applicant must be able to ride in a bus for several hours in a single day and fly in an airplane.
- Submit a completed application form, two short essays, high resolution digital photo, and one original letter of recommendation to Sam Houston Electric Cooperative, Inc. postmarked or emailed no later than midnight on January 31, 2024.

A completed application, two short essays, list of extracurricular activities, and original letter of recommendation must be postmarked or uploaded by midnight on Friday, Jan. 31, 2024 and should be sent to the following:
